

## CONSTRUCTION UPDATE FROM SUNZU PLAYGROUND AND MPCC FUNDRAISER

Sunzu playground is a part of a large Multi-Purpose Community Center (MPCC). This is a popular grassroots educational and peacebuilding effort in rural northern Rwanda. The MPCC has been a continuously growing initiative and we are happy to announce that we broke ground for the construction of the Sunzu playground on February 1st 2022. Initial works include building the retaining wall and the multipurpose pitch that is constructed to accommodate both Basketball and Volleyball games at the same time. There will also be an additional space reserved for 50 spectators. More news to come!

The MPCC will be an important space for locals and its completion will have lasting ripple effects on youth and adults across the region. With a larger space to hold events, meetings, vocational training, church services and more, this village will be able to continue empowering people to make better lives for themselves. This is the final phase of the development project. Past donations have been directed to site works and the land acquisition processes and the MPCC remains unbuilt due to gaps in funding and support. We hope to see the construction completed within the coming months. EAP is driving fundraising to meet this objective and raise the remaining donations needed to cover construction costs. Completing the construction of the multi-purpose center is the last part of this great project for Sunzu village. Join us and see the continued growth of a flourishing community gathering space!

## CHAPTERS NETWORK LIBRARIES

The Chapters Network has been looking to grow and share the positive impact it has had in Sunzu with other rural communities. We are happy to announce that we have successfully completed the implementation of a new library in Kaseke. Plans are now focused on implanting another library in the Little Angels School located in Kibagabaga, Kigali. Little Angels is a 200 plus student nursery and primary school.

In collaboration with two Canadian organizations, Global Excel Management (GEM) and Grace Village (GV) and with local volunteers, EAP successfully collected the funds to ship a 40 foot container full of donated books and educational materials, bicycles, medical supplies and equipment for the Malomo community center in Malawi. The container is due to arrive in the coming weeks and will go towards plans for libraries and health clinics.
